2. Please select one of the following Spirit of Volunteerism Award categories for your nominee:

- Spirit of One (This award is designed to honor the services and commitment of an individual adult volunteer 19 years of age or older. Two honorees will be selected in this category, one of which will honor service in a school setting.)
- Spirit of Team (This award recognizes a group or team of two or more adult volunteers working toward a common purpose.)
- Spirit of Youth (This award is presented to an exceptional youth volunteer or to a group whose members are 18 years or younger or still attending high school.)
- Spirit of Family (This award is designed to honor the activities of two or more family members who work together for a common purpose and demonstrate outstanding volunteer engagement.)
- Spirit of Dedication (This award honors a volunteer in our community who is age 60 or older.)
- Spirit of Inspiration (This award honors an individual who has volunteered 20 years or more for a specific organization.)
- Commitment to Community (This award honors a Hanover County business that exemplifies strong community values and a sustained commitment to supporting the community).
