**Mary White appointed as Deputy Superintendent**

For Immediate Release: On July 1, Mary N. White was named the Deputy Superintendent of the Pamunkey Regional Jail. For over thirty-six years, Major White has been involved in the correctional field, first with the Virginia Department of Corrections, and later with the Henrico County Sheriff's Office.

In July of 1997, Major White became a Jail Officer at the Pamunkey Regional Jail, where she quickly advanced through the ranks. Since January of 2000, Major White has held numerous command positions within the jail, including Lieutenant of Standards and Accreditation/Internal Affairs Division, and Captain of Administration & Operations.

In October, 2006, Major White became the Captain of Support Services, where her responsibilities included supervision of the following jail areas: Accreditation, Chaplaincy, Commissary, Food Service, Hearings, Mailroom, Inmate Programs, Staff Property, Staff Training, Visitation, Work Force, and Work Release.

Major White holds an Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice from Ashworth College, and she has completed extensive national and state executive-level criminal justice training. She is a Certified Jail Manager through the American Jail Association (AJA), and is a professional member of AJA, the American Correctional Association (ACA), and the Correctional Accreditation Managers Association (CAMA).

Major White and her husband have been happily married since 1976, and have two adult children. They reside in Ashland.
