Arrest Made in Thefts of Delivered Packages

Cassandra M. Peaco, 27, of N. Ivy Ave. in Highland Springs has been charged with two counts of petit larceny for stealing unattended packages from porches of homes.

On December 20 a delivered package containing reloading equipment and ammunition was stolen from a porch in the 8100 block of Studley Road. On December 21 a citizen observed a female attempting to steal packages from a porch in the 9100 block of Cardinal Creek Drive. Based on the information obtained from the witness, Deputies responded to N. Ivy Ave. in Highland Springs with the assistance of the Henrico Police. While at N. Ivy Ave., Deputies determined that Cassandra M. Peaco was responsible for both the December 20 and 21 incidents. Additionally Deputies recovered several other items believed to be stolen in a similar manner in Hanover County. Unfortunately the packaging material had been discarded.

Deputies are continuing their efforts to identify the owners of the stolen property. All property is believed to come from the Mechanicsville area between Chamberlayne Road and Pole Green Road. Hanover residents who reason to believe that a delivered package has been stolen are asked to contact the Sheriff's Office at 365-6140.

Peaco is scheduled to be arraigned in Hanover General District Court on January 5, 2011.
