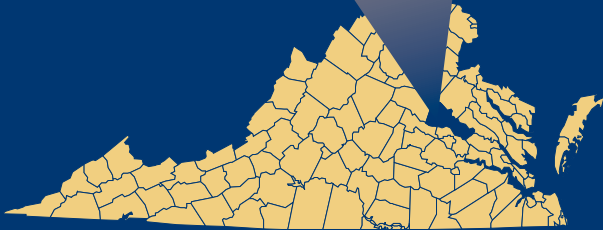

Vehicle Larceny Crime Prevention Pointers

- **Keep your vehicle locked (in 2009, 85% of the reported vehicle larcenies were from unlocked vehicles).**
- DO NOT store valuables in your vehicle.
- If you are shopping, lock items in the trunk.
- Keep valuables out of sight if your vehicle does not have a trunk.
- Have a detailed description of valuables.
- Record all serial numbers and model numbers.
- Have your driver's license number, followed by the state abbreviation (VA), engraved on valuables..
- Identity theft could be a secondary-related crime by using wallets, purses, and/or personal information from your vehicle.



- Park in a well-lighted area at night.
- Look out for any suspicious activity.
- Communicate with your neighbors.
- Be active in your Neighborhood and Business Watch.
